Teachers in prison' Training

1. Basic training

These are primarily 1st degree teachers specialized in the care of young/juvenile and adults with specific needs.

There are also some secondary school teachers in larger prisons.

Training for newly appointed teachers to teach in prison

All newly appointed full-time and part-time teachers receive a 3 weeks training period.

The first two weeks of training took place in the first year following the appointment; the third week occurs during the second year of their appointment.

1st Training's week

It takes place in the national public school for all types of prison staffs (ENAP) in Agen (near Bordeaux) for all teachers teaching in prisons in France.

OBJECTIVES of the 1st training's week

Its main objectives are to enable teachers to:

- Lying in their working environment,
- Lying professionally better by understanding roles and missions in penal environment,
- Understand, anticipate and exceed the penal constraints by working with prison staffs.

2nd and 3rd weeks training

They are held at the national institute of research and training for the education of young people with disabilities and special needs (INSHEA) in Suresnes (near Paris).

OBJECTIVES of the 2nd training's week

Objectives are:

- to highlight the educational policy in prisons,
- to know about psychological and psychiatric approaches to violence,
- to learn socio-historical approach to justice for juveniles,
- implementation of educational projects in prisons,
- to exchange on professional practices.

OBJECTIVES of the 3rd training's week

- To learn roles and missions of persons responsible for education in prison,
- To act at low levels of qualification (to fight illiteracy),
- To teach French as foreign language(FLE),
- To provide educational offers on high levels of qualification,
- To use multimedia in teaching operations,
- To exchange on professional practices.

2. LifeLong Learning

- Takes place at the regional level,
- Can help to open up other fields of education to people with specific needs,
- Is organized from institutional priorities (French as foreign language, basic skills, ICT),
- Is run by trainers from organizations outside the network of national education and prison administration.
