 - 1. The promotion of debate is a healthy way to discuss current issues to supplement lectures. Allow students to become more proficient in the language, in research, in reading and writing skills, promote reasoning and communication skills. In addition, discussions, both formal and informal, are a vehicle for learners to express their opinions assertively, in a respectful manner about a subject or a relevant theme. Thus, as first activity proposal, discussions will be held in the classroom, to check if the trainees have assimilated the exposed contents and also to know what is their opinion regarding the topic under review. so that the debates be held harmoniously should be respected all the rules of functioning of a debate.

2. Text reading and creative writing activities on "Citizenship and Environmental Issues as core values";

3. Preparation of a report with the publication of texts and jobs created.

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
