INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE

- **1.** The questionnaire will be applied by a teacher.
- 2. The applicator teacher shall:
- **2.1.** Explain the importance of the contribution of all (the) students, because the information gathered will contribute to the training of teachers who work or will work with inmates.
- **2.2.** Clarify that the participation of each is anonymous and voluntary; it is not an obligation to answer the questionnaire and should not write the name on any site of the form.
- If possible, only inmates who agree to answer should stay in the room.
- **2.3.** Write on the board the starting and ending time of the questionnaire.
- **2.4.** Explain that there are 2 types of questions, the first is subdivided into 18 items and the other 3 are open questions (to answer what you think).
- **2.5.** Explain that in the first question on each item should only make a choice, marking X in the main item selected.
- If there is a mistake, the Teacher can use white broker.
- **2.6.** Explain that in the other three questions, each one must answer only the personal opinion.
- If the answer space is insufficient, the inmate can complete the answer on the back, indicating the number of the question referred.
- **2.7.** Should only be given explanations about the meaning of vocabulary and always aloud.
- **3.** The applicator teacher should take some pens, as questions should not be written in pencil.
- **4.** Answers should be completed by the inmate in the presence of the teacher.
- **5**. Application time: It is estimated a time of 40 minutes; however, if necessary, there may be a 10-minute tolerance (1 hour class).
- **6.** Before leaving, the applicator teacher collect all the questionnaires, will close them in an envelope and will make them reach the Training Centre.
